On 10.11.2015 by the national Legal Aid week was observed by Bhoomika International Development Trust. Debate & Essay competition among High School Girls was organized and prizes of merit are distributed.

1.3 AWARENESS ON DRUG ABUSE:

Like every year this year also the we organized a seminar on drug abuse among college students in D. K. N. College, Erancha, Cuttack.

1.4 AWARENESS ON UPCOMING KOVID -19 PANDAMIC

Awareness programme was conducted in various colleges and schools and Basties regarding the upcoming and ongoing problems of pandemic Covid-19 and protection to be taken to avoid spreading of the disease.

1.4 AWARENESS CAMP ON CHILD & WOMEN LABOR:

In Sailasahi colony, BBSR. We organized a awareness camp among the women and children on the labor act and aware the women not to engage the children in labor work and avail different schemes of govt for their study.

COMMUNITY HEALTH

Unhygienic condition in the rural villages in operational area causes several diseases resulting large number of causalities every year. The organization has organized a number of awareness camps in collaboration with Mamata.

2.1 OBSERVANCE OF WORLD AIDS DAY:

QUIZ COMPITION:

A quiz competition was organized among the students. A number of 30 questions were asked by quiz master Mr U.R.Mohanty and prizes were awarded to the winners on the spot. The questions set for quiz were based on AIDS.

SEMINAR:

On the same day a seminar on AIDS was organized in the conference hall of ITI, Cuttack. Hon'ble speakers delivered speech on cause, effects and methods of prevention of AIDS and HIV. Mj. Dr. Kalpana Das shared with the participants regarding the provisions made in District and activities undertaken to prevent AIDS and HIV patients. Mr. Gopal Krushna Mishra, E.D., ANTARDRUSTI shared with the participants about the provisions available in District counseling centers.

2.2 HEALTH CARE

Formal health care system are absent in most of the villages and particularly in the remote areas at the time of flood situation. Keeping this in eye the organization organized free health check up by Doctors in the campus of ASHRYA and SCHOLL OF LEARNING at BBSR.

ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

High growth of population, development of science & technology, having use of vehicles, chemicals and pesticides are caused environmental pollution which affected the society directly the organization has taken up various programmes to protect the environmental population.

3.1 WORKSHOP ON CLIMATE CHANGE:

With the support of MAMATA NGO this year we have organized awareness workshop on climate change in Daya Vihar Degree College, Puri. Different competitions were organized and prizes of merit were awarded to the winners. Mr. U. R. Mohanty attended the workshops as Chief Speaker and Chaired by Mj. Dr. Kalpana Das.

3.2 SCHOOL PLANTATION

As a follow up programme to make awareness among school students on environmental protection, organization has organized a plantation in the school premises with awareness meeting and competitions of different groups were given responsibility of after care.

3.4 Science Exhibition:

The major problem we are going to face in the field of environment is Global Warming. As it becomes a major challenge for the environmentalist our organization this year organized a Science Exhibition on Issues, Impacts, and Remedies of Global warming in L. N. High School, Erancha.

DISASTER MANAGEMENT AND RESPONSE

As Odisha is one of the disaster prone state. It is always in a situation to face the disasters like flood and cyclone. In this situation it is the need to make aware of the people on disaster management.

4.1 DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:

Selected volunteers from different villages were formed the village taskforce team and the trainings on Search & Rescue, First Aid and Physiological First Aid were imparted by the Volunteers. All the village and GP plans were updated this year. To make the people habituated to face disaster.

4.2 DISASTER RESPONSE:

Bhoomika International Development Trust this year made tremendous activities in case of disaster response. In Phoni response we have distributed food packets for 150 families in Kanas and Balipatana Block of Puri district. A number of 25 fair victim family of Kenderapada district were supported by polithin and food packets as immediate support.

4.3 COVID 19 RESPONSE:

This Year the major disaster the entire world faced is COVID 19 which damaged the economy of large number of people and institutions. For precautions from COVID mask and sanitizers were distributed to the frontline warriors the Traffic Police in BBSR.

To make greater awareness on COVID 19 a series of webinars were organized by our organization which were shared Dr. Bimal Kumar Panda and use of Yoga in the period of COVID by Dr. Susil Kumar Pattnaik.

Mask and sanitizers with food packets were distributed to the people on the street at BBSR and Cuttack.
